## Healing & Power in the Sacraments

In today's Gospel, Jesus used ordinary elements of clay and water to convey his healing power. The blind man could not see Jesus, but Jesus came to him through touch and hearing. In the first reading, God works in a similar way. Samuel, under instructions from God, anointed David with oil, and the Spirit of the Lord came mightily upon David from that day forward.

Jesus comes to us invisibly in each sacrament through the visible signs of "matter" and "form."

In the Sacrament of Baptism, the matter is water which is poured over the head. The form is "N., I baptize you in the Name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit."

In the Sacrament of Confirmation, the matter is the bishop anointing the forehead with the Oil of Chrism. The form is "N., Be sealed with the Gift of the Holy Spirit."

In the Sacrament of the Eucharist, the matter is bread and wine. The form is "Take this all of you and eat it, this is my Body which will be given up for you. Take this all of you and drink from it: this is the cup of my Blood, the Blood of the new and everlasting Covenant..."

In the Sacrament of Reconciliation, the matter is our sorrow, repentance, and the penance we perform. The form is, "...and I absolve you from your sins in the Name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit."

In the Sacrament of the Anointing of the Sick, the matter is anointing with the Oil of the Sick on the forehead and on the palms of the hand. The form is, "N., through this holy anointing, may the Lord in his love and mercy help you through the grace of the Holy Spirit. May the Lord who frees you from sin, save you, and raise you up."

In the Sacrament of Holy Orders, the matter is the laying on of hands by the bishop on the head of the man being ordained. The form is the Prayer of Consecration immediately following the laying on of hands.

When David was chosen by God as king, the Spirit of the Lord came mightily upon him as he was anointed. When the blind man was healed by Jesus, healing came as he was anointed with a paste of clay and he washed in the Pool. God uses the ordinary elements of nature to convey his power and healing to us in every sacrament - Jesus comes to us invisibly but powerfully. As you receive the sacraments you hear Jesus, and Jesus touches you.
