Journeying Through Doubt

DIVINE MERCY SUNDAY

We often say, "Seeing is believing." Today, we hear Jesus say, "You believe in me, Thomas, because you have seen me. Happy are those who have not seen me but still believe." It seems as though Jesus was scolding St. Thomas for his lack of faith. But there are many ways to come to faith; perhaps for some people, doubting may be the only way to find their God.

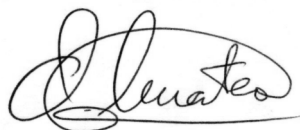
Faith is a life-long process of exploration, discovery and growth. Sometimes the journey is filled with all kinds of detours and ways that seem unsure and unsafe. St. Thomas had to struggle to make sense of his journey of faith. He had to be sure, but once he experienced the truth, he went all out. "My Lord and my God", a real profession of faith. He gives us an example of what it means to doubt and then come to a deeper faith, strengthened by the search and struggle that is so much a part of our daily lives.

The Scripture on this first week after Easter reminds us that our journey of faith is filled with doubt and darkness, failure and fear, locked doors and closed minds. There may be even some turmoil and confusion. We are to look carefully at our journey to notice that there are times when our faith seems to be out of focus. It is exactly during those times of trial that faith can be renewed and strengthened. We cannot become people of faith unless we are willing to deal with those difficulties, that darkness, those doubts or those impossible situations, this mystery called life. We cannot become patient people unless we are tested and tried by all kinds of opportunities to be impatient. We will never learn to be gentle and loving unless we are first tempted to be mean and hateful. People of faith continue to ask, to learn and to search out the truth. We are on our way, a pilgrim people just as the Second Vatican Council reminds us so often.

We gather here like the disciples in the Upper Room. Some were fearful. Some doubted. Some were resentful. Some were sure of what was happening, but had questions. Some of us are so afraid of doubt that growth in faith has stopped. Others might realize that doubts differ from unbelief and that they bring about a greater faith. St. Thomas could remind us all that faith without some difficulty really isn't much faith after all.

Every once in a while, we need to use new words and have new experiences of what we believe. Our God cannot be contained in a creed or limited to a formula or sets of rules and regulations. We need reminders that we worship only God, not the words that speak of Him.

In spite of all our doubts, we are people of faith. All of us are believers in the Risen Christ and His Good News. We express our faith in the way we live out our days, one day at a time.
