We Are the Body of Christ

Today's reading from Deuteronomy is about preparing for a relationship with God through the covenant He established. This reading appears as something of an admonition to those who have come through the desert from the bondage of slavery, thanks to God and His interventions: *"Do not forget the Lord, your God, Who brought you out of Egypt, that place of slavery, Who guided you through the vast and terrible desert with its serpents and scorpions, its parched and waterless ground."*

The focal point for Israel's memory of God's saving action is manna, *"A food unknown to you and your fathers,"* Moses says. Moses' memory and experience recollects God's wonders for those who have missed God's action in person. Manna is a sign of God's favors for His people and a reminder of His power in times of difficulty, pain and confusion.

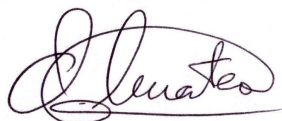
For over 2,000 years, we have been gathering in Jesus' name to share a simple meal of bread and wine. We come together as God's very own family to give thanks and to remember Who that bread is and what He did for us. We celebrate this mystery in memory of the One we profess to love.

Jesus tells us again: *"I am the living bread come down from heaven. My flesh is real food and my blood real drink. The person who feeds on Me will have life because of Me."* Those are hard words to understand and sometimes they frighten us. As people of faith, we truly believe that Jesus is present under these signs of bread and wine. It is a mystery! How He is there, we truly do not know. But we really do believe He is. We can spend all kinds of time trying to understand "how" He is present and miss "why" He is there.

Jesus gave us the Eucharist in remembrance of all that He said and did, so that we might become like Him. Do this as you recall all that I have said and done. Do this and remember that I am with you during the good times and the bad. I am with you to encourage and strengthen you, to renew and refresh your tired minds and hearts. Do this and know that I have come that you may have life and have it in abundance. Do this and realize that you shall live forever. Do this and know that you are my body.

The Eucharist is not magical. If we receive the Lord and never understand the main purpose - to make us all one in the Lord - then what we share will have little effect in our lives. We gather as brothers and sisters in the Lord, to be nourished and renewed for our journey. We linger at table to appreciate the Lord as our companion as we together make our way to the Father.

All of us are invited to that banquet table, rich or poor, young or old, saint or sinner. We are not orphans, but members of God's household. We are to know the needs of our brothers and sisters. We are to share our lives with those less fortunate. Why? Because we are the Body of Christ.
