ORDINARY TIME 13

First Things First

There is none of us who likes to be left out, ignored, unappreciated, betrayed, laughed at or abandoned. We need to be included, accepted, supported, appreciated and loved, to feel that we belong. That is the main reason why we gather together. Any excuse will do - the fourth of July, a family reunion, a wedding celebration or anniversary, a birthday party, dinner with a good friend, a baptism, a funeral, etc. We need to be here together, with one another and with our God, included and welcomed as God's holy people.

Jesus tells us: *"He who welcomes you, welcomes me and he who welcomes me, welcomes the one who sent me."* We are to welcome one another, offer hospitality and make ourselves at home. Not only here in our Church, but out in the world wherever we go. We live in a world where strangers soon become enemies. Whom we do not know, we soon come to misunderstand and fear. The welcoming that Jesus asks of us invites us to overcome barriers, feelings of selfishness, pride and fear. He would have us make time in our busy lives to welcome those whom we encounter each day - especially the lonely, the betrayed, the alienated and the neglected. Most of us do not like interference in our routines, and yet it is exactly those experiences that make life an adventure, open our hearts and minds to those in need of our time, care, love, respect and concern. A welcoming person always has time for others and for God. There must always be time for the work of the kingdom.

The Lord asks us to put first things first. We are to make Him Lord of our lives. Jesus knows that in choosing Him and His ways above anyone and everything else, our love for one another becomes greater. If we seek only for ourselves, we become failures at what we do and who we are. We cannot thrive in a self-centered world. In order to know who we are for ourselves, for others and for God, we must first learn to lose ourselves, forget ourselves, empty ourselves so that we might be filled with that love that is given in Our Lord. That is exactly what St. Paul is talking about in the second reading.

Now, if you welcome those lowly ones, you will not want for a reward. It does not matter even if you give just a cup of water. Lowly ones have very little. They cannot repay your kindness. But God Who knows your every deed will satisfy and fulfill "your hearts desire." *"For what you have done to the least of my friends you have done to Me."* That sounds familiar, doesn't it?

God has welcomed us as His people. He has made us a chosen race, a royal priesthood, a holy nation, a people set apart. We have been called out of the darkness of sin into the brightness of a marvelous new light. In that new light, we are to welcome all who come to us; all those in need, giving a cup of cool water to those who thirst for our love.
