True Freedom

On the Fourth of July, we commemorate the independence of our great nation and the many blessings that come with it. We have much to be thankful for as we come to worship our God. We rejoice in that freedom, aware that there are many forces in our world that can take away our liberty. But it is Jesus, the Lord of life, who shows us how to be free people.

Thousands of years ago, the Israelites were in bondage in Egypt. God saw their suffering and sent Moses to lead them out of slavery to the freedom of the Promised Land. Jesus is our new Moses who leads us out of the bondage that enslaves us. Many do not even realize that they are in slavery, addicted to money, power and prestige, pleasure, gambling, drugs and alcohol, to all those values that deprive people of freedom. The human spirit was meant to be free; it is freedom that brings us real life, joy, peace and happiness.

Jesus tells us: *"Come to me all you who are weary and find life burdensome and I will refresh you. Take my yoke upon your shoulders and learn from me for I am gentle and humble of heart."* What are we to learn from the Lord?

We must let go and let God be God. We are to be as little children, having simplicity, a trust and confidence that God will take care of our every need. We are to learn what it means to live with a total dependence upon Our Father. We are to live for the moment and not borrow problems from the past nor be anxious about the future. *"Look at the birds of the air and the lilies of the field. All of us need someone to share the anxieties of our hearts and the stress of everyday living. There is an old saying, *"Friendship doubles our joy and divides our grief."* God knows our needs long before we realize them. Our prayer is to be about giving ourselves to God in hope and trust and then allowing God to give Himself to us.

If we are looking for freedom, then Jesus' yoke fits us well. We do not have to go through life alone. He is always with us, closer to ourselves than we are. It is not how busy we are, how hard we work, or how much we accumulate. What counts in the end is how much we love. To follow in His ways does not assure us of an easy life; it may bring some heartache and trouble because we will be different. Our love will make that yoke easy and the burden light, for the Lord is with us. God bless you for believing in love!

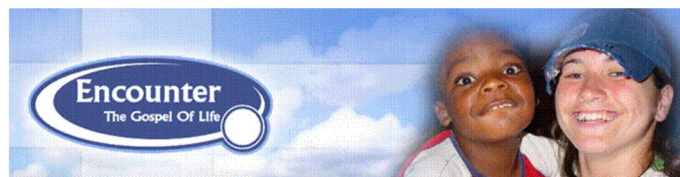
