Who Is Jesus? Who Are We?

August 27, 2017 ORDINARY TIME 21

Isn't it true that we all wonder who we are, where we are going and what is going to happen after we die? We truly live a mystery. Each day that we live, life unfolds and we learn and understand a little more about this mystery. We learn who we are from those around us and what they tell us. But it is going to take a lifetime of experiences to know the full story. Maybe, we will never know it all until we meet our God face-to-face. What a revelation that will be!

Our Lord was eager to know what His followers thought of Him. Who is He and what is He all about anyhow? They were eager to report what others had to say about Him. They really were not sure, although Jesus must have been pleased to be numbered among some of the greatest of their faith. But that was not what He was looking for. He wanted to know: Who do YOU say that I am? And St. Peter expressed it clearly, "You are the Messiah, the Son of the Living God." With faith, St. Peter spoke out the hopes and dreams that others did not know or quite understand.

Today, Jesus asks you and me the same question. Who do YOU say that I am? And how do you respond? Do you know Him from what others have told you or do you know Him from a deep personal faith experience? Is this Jesus still locked up in the pages of history or is He real and present in your everyday life? Is He the invisible man, living somewhere up there, or do you see Him in the people, places, events and circumstances of each day? There are many that know all about Him but really never know Him. We can proclaim Him Lord of our lives, using all kinds of beautiful words, and then forget to live out what being Lord of our life means.

The answer that we give to the Lord is not just an intellectual or theological response. Who this Jesus is tells us who we must be. What this Jesus does shows us how we must act. The answer then becomes a day after day lifetime work, a lived experience. We tell the world who Jesus is by who and what we are. That is the only answer we can give. What we believe is lived out in each of our lives.

We say we believe that Jesus is the way, the truth and the life. To understand a little more of this mystery we live, we might want to ask ourselves if we really believe that. Is His way our way, or do we have a better idea of how to live out our time? Do we count on His opinion in prayer before making any decision? Are his truths our values, or are we driven only by our selfish wants and desires? Is His life of giving and sacrifice too much to ask, or are we

willing to accept that challenge He presents to us? Perhaps we should ask the Lord: Who do you say that I am? And then listen quietly for His response and act on it with all we have.
