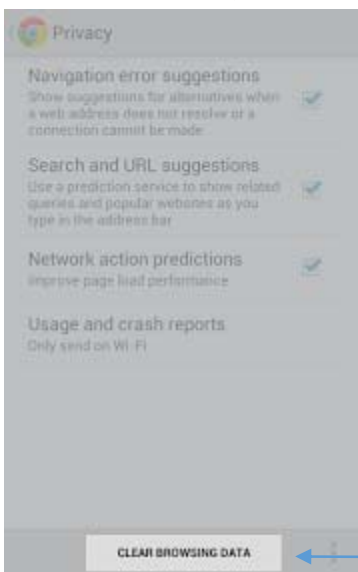

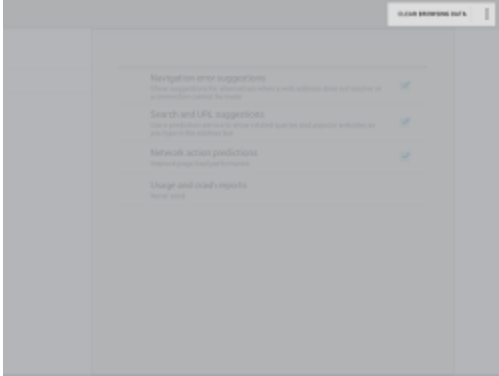

Chrome for Android

1. Touch **Chrome menu > Settings**.
2. Touch **(Advanced) Privacy**.
3. Touch **Clear browsing data**.





4. To correct this specific issue, “Cache” needs to be checked and all other browsing data options are unchecked.
5. Touch the blue “Clear” option at the bottom right of the screen
6. Back out of the other screens

You can see all your browsing history by typing [chrome:history](#) in the address bar.

Chrome for iOS

1. Touch **Chrome menu** > **Settings**.
2. Touch **Privacy**.
3. Choose the data type you want to clear.
4. Touch **Clear**.
