## Review and Renew

**February 12, 2017**  
**ORDINARY TIME 6**

Today's Gospel is both life-giving and very challenging. We may say, "I don't murder people, I don't commit adultery and I don't perjure myself." Most people don't do these things; the Lord is teaching us today that being salt and light is much deeper than not doing those specific things.

"You shall not commit murder." We can destroy people in more subtle ways - by ignoring others who think or act differently; through hatred, defamation, slander, senseless anger, abusive words; by our attitudes and contempt for others. We can destroy a person's good name by wounding insult, by trivializing their self-worth, by dropping suggestive and malicious hints about their character. We are salt and light when we respect human dignity and don't engage in personal insult or ridicule.

"You shall not commit adultery." We can commit infidelity of the heart - by fantasizing or toying with temptation, by disengaging from the life of the family. Though many couples are married in the legal sense, many are emotionally divorced from each other. Those who commit themselves to give life to their family are salt and light.

"You shall not commit perjury." Our word should be clear and dependable, not loaded with loopholes, half truths, mental reservations, hidden intentions and lies. Human conversation has become a game; even though we know what people are saying, we are not sure what they mean. Jesus calls us to be people of truth, whose words are dependable and reliable.

The Lord asks us to look within ourselves, because our attitudes always precede our actions.

- The measure of violence in our society is found in the ways we put people down, despise others, gossip, hold grudges. Murder becomes just the next immediate step in a society already steeped in hate.
- The measure of the breakdown of family life comes from the lack of serious commitment and responsibility to our family relationships.
- The degree of untruth in our society is found in all the lies, evasions, deceptions and half truths that we see in ourselves, in others and in so many parts of our society.

Our Christian identity is defined not only by what we don't do, but by what we do. Before we act or make a decision, we always have the chance to review and renew our life, to examine the choices we are making and to look at the truth and fidelities that are shaping our Christian life. Every Sunday is a call to remodel our lives into places of salt and light. We can not do so much about the world and people around us, but we can do a lot about the world inside us.
