Our Beautiful Family

June 11, 2017
HOLY TRINITY

Today, we are celebrating the Solemnity of the Most Holy Trinity, One God and Three Persons equally divine.

We all like to belong - to a family, a parish, a community, a group of friends... No one is an island. We need the love, support and friendship of others. We all need to belong. When we move to a new town, we might say that the people welcomed us. We try to get to know others so that we don't feel like an outsider. When we grow up in a happy family, we are well set up for life. If the family environment is less than happy, it may leave scars. If those scars are not healed before marriage or adult life, can you be such a loving husband or wife or friend that you can help to heal the scars of your loved one?

In the Old Testament, God was called "Yahweh." When Moses saw the burning bush and asked God his name, "I am who I am" was the name God gave himself (Exodus 3:14), which became "Yahweh." Then, Jesus came and we learned that there were two Persons in God. As Jesus ascended, He promised us the Holy Spirit, who came at Pentecost. By way of divine revelation, we then knew there were Three Persons in God. God is a Trinity of Persons and the happiest of families. They are totally united in love for each other. We call this love of the Father for the Son, and the love of the Son for the Father, the Holy Spirit.

Jesus called His Father, "Abba" (Mark 14:36), the Aramaic word for "Daddy." Jesus called the Holy Spirit the Counselor or Paraclete (John 14:16, 26; 15:26; 16:7); in other words, the Holy Spirit is interceding or mediating for us. The Holy Spirit exists for us, assuring us that we are sons and daughters of God. It is a Spirit that makes us call our heavenly Father "Abba" or "Daddy."

Because God's family is such a happy one, God wants to share the happiness with us. God invites us to belong. This happened first when we were created in the image and likeness of God, and second when we were baptized. We were adopted as God's sons or daughters! We belong to God. Jesus is the Son of God, and we also are a son or daughter of God. What does that mean? It means that Jesus is your brother! His Father is also your Father, your Abba, your Daddy. You belong to the family of the Trinity.

If you are the son or daughter of a rich father, you would expect to be his heir. We are all sons and daughters of the richest of fathers! He is Abba, our Father in heaven. We are heirs to God's unimaginable riches. We belong to the Father, Son and Holy Spirit. How privileged we are to grow up in such a beautiful family! Turn to the Father, Son and Holy Spirit in prayer every day, for we truly belong to their family.
