Wheat & Weeds

Sooner or later, we all come to the conclusion that we don't live in a perfect world and life is not perfect. We know this because there is suffering, betrayal, pain and death. There are good days and bad days. We all have faults and failures. We are all flawed and handicapped in one way or another. We are all in need of a Savior, a Redeemer, someone to make things all right and good. That is what the parable of the weeds is all about.

The Apostles thought they knew all about good and evil, blessings and curses, virtue and vice, but they really didn't understand. They were fishermen who lifted their nets and sorted their catch. The good fish go here, and those not edible go there. They wondered why the Lord didn't destroy evil, once and for all. Good and evil are very much a part of our own lives, very much a part of the lives of those around us and part of the organizations and institutions to which we all belong, including the Church. The weeds grow along with the wheat until the day of harvest. Like the wise farmer, our God waits with infinite patience and love until the end of time. The final harvest is in His hands, not in ours. It still is His creation. We are His people. One fine day, this mystery will be sorted out. But for now, you and I are challenged to live with this mixture of good and evil, truth and falsehood, beauty and ugliness.

This problem of evil has baffled the minds of all the great thinkers throughout the ages. Maybe the only answer to why weeds and wheat grow together is so that we might appreciate the goodness and love that is there to be harvested. If we never experience evil, would we ever know the good?

When you stop and think about it, each of us is a mixed field, like the soil in last week's parable. Our faults and virtues grow side by side. The weeds of impatience and anger grow along with the wheat of forgiveness and love. The most amazing part of being human is that in spite of all of our faults and failures, all of our foolishness and all of our weeds, much good grain does grow. We must never become discouraged over our progress in the life of the kingdom. There are many times each day people count on us for support and help, comfort and friendship, advice and love. Many times during our day it is our goodness, patience, forgiveness and charity that brings about the care, concern and love in others. We overcome evil by doing good and not letting evil overcome the good we do.

The parable really speaks about the mercy and love for all God has created. Paul reminds us that the Spirit will help us in our weakness. We are to learn to see people as God sees them. God knows that every saint has a past and every sinner has a future. Our world will find its fulfillment in God's reign only after the harvest has been gathered into His barn.

These plants have been selected for their resistance to both deer and drought and are labeled for easy identification. Additionally, these native plants serve local farmers as pollinators, and are particularly beneficial to bees, birds, and butterflies so crucial for the cultivation of fruits and vegetables. The nine milkweed plants and variety of succulents have enabled us to receive certification as an official Monarch Butterfly Waystation, a place to pause on their long journey to Canada.
