WORDS FROM OUR PASTOR / PALABRAS DE NUESTRO PASTOR

Today, on this feast of the Ascension, we hear Jesus tell His followers they are to continue the mission that He has entrusted to them. They are not to stand around, looking up at the sky, wondering what to do next once He is gone from their midst. They will have the necessary gifts, the strength, courage and power to do some wonderful things. He promised that His Spirit would be with them all days until the end of time. They only had to trust in His promise if ever they would be able to bear witness to all He had told them.

Witness is a wonderful word if understood correctly for us. We can be present and witness an event like news reporters. We can witness during a court trial or be present at a signing of a decree or law. To witness the Scripture has to do with our personal knowledge of Jesus. If we are to be witnesses of the Lord and His way of living, we need to give evidence of what we believe. That evidence can be observed and judged by what we say and do each day in our lives. We preach more by who we are.

St. Paul affirms today, **"Brothers and sisters I urge you to live in a manner worthy of the call you have received."** The key words he lists are humility and gentleness, with patience for one another and preserving the bond of peace. He goes on to say, **"There is one Lord, one faith, one baptism, one God and Father of us all who is over all and through all and in all!"** These are beautiful words to ponder and reflect upon. You and I are to be one in mind and heart to evidence and witness what we believe.

That does not mean that we are to be all the same. In fact, God has made us all different, unique and in that beautiful diversity each of us continues the ministry of the Lord. All of us have special gifts and talents to share. Some of us make our worship experience mean meaningful and the Lord challenges us to proclaim good news in a world that longs for purpose, meaning and happiness.

We give evidence and witness to what we believe by our sharing with the people who suffer. This is a powerful experience for all of us. However, the ministry of Jesus continues every day and we are to be signs of His presence. Take some time this week to notice the needs of those around you. Be the evidence they need to believe the Good News.

Solo tenían que confiar en su promesa si alguna vez serían capaces de dar testimonio de todo lo que les había dicho.

Testigo es una palabra maravillosa si se entiende correctamente para nosotros. Podemos estar presentes y ser testigos de un evento como los reporteros de noticias. Podemos ser testigos durante un juicio o estar presentes en la firma de un decreto o ley. Dar testimonio de las Escrituras tiene que ver con nuestro conocimiento personal de Jesús. Si queremos ser testigos del Señor y de su manera de vivir, debemos dar evidencia de lo que creemos. Esa evidencia puede ser observada y juzgada por lo que decimos y hacemos cada día en nuestras vidas.

San Pablo afirma hoy: **"Hermanos y hermanas, los exhorto a vivir de una manera digna de la llamada que han recibido"**. Las palabras clave que enumera son humildad y dulzura, con paciencia el uno por el otro y preservando el vínculo de la paz. Continúa diciendo: **"¡Hay un Señor, una fe, un bautismo, un Dios y Padre de todos nosotros, que somos todos sobre todos, en todos y en todos!"**. Estas son bellas palabras para meditar y reflexionar. Usted y yo debemos ser uno en mente y corazón para evidenciar y atestiguar lo que creemos.

Eso no quiere decir que debemos ser iguales. De hecho, Dios nos ha hecho a todos diferentes, únicos y en esa hermosa diversidad, cada uno de nosotros continúa el ministerio del Señor. Todos nosotros tenemos dones y talentos especiales para compartir. Algunos de nosotros hacemos que nuestra experiencia de adoración tenga sentido y el Señor nos desafía a proclamar buenas nuevas en un mundo que anhela propósito, significado y felicidad.

Damos evidencia y somos testigos de lo que creemos al compartir con las personas que sufren. Esta es una experiencia poderosa para todos. Sin embargo, el ministerio de Jesús continúa todos los días y debemos ser signos de su presencia. Tómese su tiempo esta semana para darse cuenta de las necesidades de quienes le rodean. Sean la evidencia que necesitan para creer la Buena Nueva.

QUESTION: WHY IS THE HOLY SPIRIT CALLED THE "PARACLETE"?

ANSWER: Last week we were speaking about the unique role of Jesus in human salvation. Salvation is not simply about "following the rules" but, rather, it is about being healed and freed from the wounds and slavery of sin at the deepest level of our souls. Yes, the commandments of God are important; but, as Jesus reminds us in much of his preaching, it is just as important to be *re-formed* in our internal dispositions as it is to change our external behavior. He speaks of the Holy Spirit as "advocate" or "paraclete" who will come into our hearts through the sacrament of baptism. But, what is a "paraclete."

In various parts of the New Testament, especially in St. Paul's writings, we see the word "exhort" – "I exhort you brothers and sister" (Rom 12:1) – which appears as *parakalo* in Greek. To exhort means to give strong encouragement to do something. In the spiritual life we realize that it is not only the words of the scriptures that give us encouragement to move forward, but it is also the Holy Spirit that dwells within us that gives us encouragement to make progress in the spiritual life. In this sense, the indwelling Holy Spirit serves as a "paraclete" – i.e., as an internal dynamism that gives us the moral energy to grow.

The word "paraclete" also carries other meanings. It can refer to one who provides confort and consolation. It also carries the meaning of legal advocate – one who gives council and advise in difficult and complex matters. To put it in more earthy language, the word means "sidekick." In all of these ways, we can see why the Holy Spirit is called a "paraclete" and why this Third Person of the Blessed Trinity is essential for salvation. Without the spiritual dynamism provided by the Holy Trinity the spiritual life would be impossible. But, through our baptism into the Body of Christ, all things become possible.

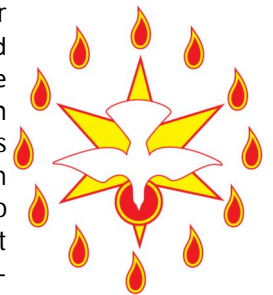
